This letter is to inform you of our plans to conduct a meeting on Wednesday, January 19, 2000. The meeting will be at 7:00 p.m. in the Radisson Hotel - John Deere Commons, 1415 River Drive, Moline, Illinois. This will be a meeting between the NRC and the public.

The purpose of this meeting is to meet with invited community leaders and members of public interest groups for a "roundtable" discussion of the agency's revised reactor oversight process. The NRC is seeking feedback from the public on how well it's revised reactor oversight process meets the following four strategic program objectives: 1) to maintain safety by establishing an oversight framework that ensures continued safe plant operation; 2) to enhance public confidence in the agency; 3) to improve effectiveness and efficiency through an oversight process by focusing resources on the most risk significant issues; and 4) to reduce unnecessary regulatory burden for licensees and the NRC. The roundtable portion of the meeting will be open to public observation. Members of the general public will have an opportunity to present their views about the new oversight process to NRC officials afterward.
