As American citizens, and particularly as parents, we are violently opposed to creation of ANY radioactive material. This includes any means of rendering non-radioactive material radioactive. We are equally opposed to the release of any radioactive material into the marketplace or elsewhere in the environment.

It is our fervent wish that all nuclear power plants be de-commissioned straightaway, all spent fuel be stored where it was spent and that all shipments of radioactive materials cease immediately.

Lastly, we are opposed IN THE EXTREME to NASA's (or anyone's) launching of plutonium, or any fissionable material, into space. We find their negligence, in using rocket boosters with a high incidence of catastrophic failure, virtually criminal. After the Cassini-space probe mishap which, save for loud protest, would likely have happened on Earth, before Cassini reached Mars, any further space launches of fissionable material must not be allowed.
