Sir or Madame:

It's my understanding that NRC is considering allowing radioactive wastes -- particularly from commercial nuclear reactors and weapons programs -- to be "recycled", incorporated or combined into various consumer products, building materials and other products.

It's also my understanding that any contaminated products containing radioactive wastes would not be disclosed to the American public and/or consumers in advance.

This proposed policy is absolutely absurd and outrageous.

It has been my assumption that NRC is a federal agency that should be looking out for the best interests of the American public, including our health and safety.

Adopting any such policy by NRC could NOT serve the health and safety interests of the American public in any form whatsoever.

I ask and urge NRC to oppose any such policies that could allow any radioactive wastes from being recycled or combined with any other raw materials or within any related processes, in order to produce any end products that could contain radioactive wastes.

In conclusion, I oppose NRC adopting proposed rule 64 FR 35090, 6/30/1999, in its entirety or any sub-portion thereof.
