What is the Nuclear Regulatory Commission regulating? Your consideration of recycling radioactive materials along with regular materials could be considered a criminal act. I look to the NRC, the EPA and other such government agencies for protection, not agreement to introducing further possibly toxic elements into the environment. If there is any question of toxicity the practice should be denied.

Cancer is already prevalent here. To add more radioactivity into our surroundings is, I repeat, a criminal act.
