Docket 50-305 Operating License DPR-43 Kewaunee Nuclear Power Plant <u>Reactor Protection and Engineered Safety Features Upgrade Project (TAC MA5396)</u>

Reference: Training Session on E-3 Protection System between the Nuclear Regulatory Commission staff, Westinghouse Electric Company staff, and Wisconsin Public Service Corporation staff at Westinghouse Electric Company in Pittsburgh from November 29, 1999 to December 2, 1999.

Wisconsin Public Service Corporation (WPSC) is proposing changes to the Reactor Protection System (RPS) and Engineered Safety Feature (ESF) process protection and relay cabinets at the Kewaunee Nuclear Power Plant. The purpose of this letter is to provide requested information on the presentation delivered during the referenced meeting. A license amendment request for KNPP is planned for submittal to the NRC by the end of 2000 with NRC approval requested by mid-year 2001.

- 2. One copy of the Non-proprietary Class 3 report, "E3 System Presentation."
