The information to which the NRC denied access consists of certain parts of the Comprehensive Evaluation Report on the Babcock and Wilcox Plant, Apollo, Pennsylvania, dated November 1978. Parts of the report contain information relating to nuclear material accountability measurements which must be protected as restricted data pursuant to sections 2161 through 2165 of the Atomic Energy Act, as amended (42 U.S.C. 2161-2165). Additional information in the report was denied because it reflects details of the physical security which are still operational at the plant. By our response to the NRC made available the report with the exception of those parts which must be denied under the Atomic Energy Act and NRC regulations.
