Enclosed is a corrected copy of the transcript taken during the public meeting held in Chicago during December 7-8, 1999, concerning the Control of Release of Solid Materials at Licensed Facilities. As a representative of the Portland Cement Association (PCA), I was a participant of the meeting. I have corrected recording errors of my statements and made comments in the margins of the transcript to improve the readability of my statements.

I understand from the statement of Mr. Don Cool of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) during the meeting, that the transcript will; (a) become part of the administrative record and (b) have the same standing as written comments received during the public comment period.

The PCA requests that the enclosed corrected transcript be entered in the administrative record as written comments on any proposed rule concerning Control of Release of Solid Materials at Licensed Facilities. Further that the verbal comments memorialized in the transcript be addressed in any response to comments concerning this issue written by NRC and published in Federal Register notices.

PCA is requesting that the corrected transcript in its entirety be entered into the administrative record as written comments.
