Dear U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission:

Here is my input on your proposal to recycle slightly radioactive materials into the regular civilian commercial market.

My first inclination is DON'T DO IT.

by second thought is to only do it in those cases where under the worst possible circumstances there is a less than one in 100,000,000 chance of causing radiation exposure in excess of 10% of what the exposure would be in the absense of the recycled material in the final consumer product or industrial product.

To me, the cost of health problems and resulting suffering would otherwise (i.e. with less stringent limits) far outweigh the value of the recycled materials and the freed-up storage space.

Certainly, any decision in this matter must be based on careful analysis of all the pertinent variables. I would like to be sent a copy of such analysis before a decision is announced.
