The Illinois Department of Nuclear Safety has checked its licenses and found only one licensee that appears to meet the requirements of SP-99-075. This licensee is authorized to possess preformed depleted uranium alloy for loading, assembling, storing, ballistic testing, demilitarization/disassembly, and packaging of munitions containing depleted uranium alloy components and distribution of finished munitions to licensed U.S. Department of Defense recipients.
