SUBJECT: EXPORT LICENSE XR137 - LUNG MEN NUCLEAR POWER PLANTS
UNITS 1 AND 2

Dear Mr. Paggen:

On February 17, 1981, NRC issued licenses to Combustion Engineering and two other U.S. companies which authorized the export of two nuclear power reactors to Taiwan Power Company. The licenses were issued to the companies in order that they might qualify to bid on the Taiwan projects; each license was conditioned to become effective only upon award by the Taiwan Power Company to the licensee of a firm order for the specified units.

As you are aware, Taiwan Power Company selected a company other than Combustion Engineering to supply the two nuclear power reactors. We are, therefore, advising you at this time that export license XR137, issued to Combustion Engineering on February 17, 1981, is being terminated.
