I believe it is within the existing law to require NRC licensees to notify Native American Tribes of shipments of certain types of high-level radioactive waste, including spent nuclear fuel, prior to transport to or across the boundary of Tribal lands.

Current NRC regulations require advance notification of these shipments to States.

In recognition of Tribal sovereignty and the need for Tribes to be informed about activities that occur on Tribal lands, the NRC needs to extend these regulations to include advance notification of these shipments to Federally recognized Native American Tribes.
