Failure of All FTS 2000 Phones and Commercial Telephone System

In the event that all the FTS 2000 Phones and the commercial telephone system have failed, the Utility Microwave Network (See Section C) can be used (if operable) to contact the NRC Operations Center (Comparison) through DE&S or ISO - New England.

<u>NOTE</u>

If an NRC classified emergency notification (above an Unusual Event) is being initiated, the NRC will most likely request a continuous open line with Vermont Yankee. To avoid tying up one of the limited lines through DE&S, the ISO - New England link should be utilized for this purpose.

a. Duke Engineering & Services

1) Contact DE&S by dialing

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- 2) Advise DE&S Switchboard of the telephone failures.
- 3) Request DE&S to press the AFRL button on the top right portion of the attendant console. Do not hang-up until the action has been completed. The AFRL switch will light up red when activated.
- 4) After hanging up with DE&S, contact the NRC Operations Center by dialing **Content of Content of Content**.
- 5) After making the appropriate notification to the NRC, inform the NRC that to contact the Vermont Yankee Control Room, the NRC must first contact DE&S (Control Room), who will then transfer the call to the VY Control Room.

6) Advise plant management (and essential personnel during backshift operation) of the need to refrain from making outside calls due to the minimal number of outside lines available in this period of degraded communications capability.

b. ISO - New England Link

<u>NOTE</u>

This link may be established with VELCO via the dedicated microwave line from the Control Room if ISO - New England is not available.

- 1) Contact ISO New England via the dedicated microwave line from the Control Room.
- Advise them of the telephone failures, and that they will be utilized to establish a link between the NRC Operations Center and the Vermont Yankee Control Room, utilizing their conferencing call mode.
- 3) Request ISO New England to call the NRC Operations Center in Rockville, MD (Control of the NRC that VY is utilizing ISO - New England to establish a communications link between the Vermont Yankee Control Room and the NRC Operations Center because of degraded communications capability at VY.
- 4) After making the appropriate notification to the NRC, inform the NRC that to contact the Vermont Yankee Control Room, the NRC must first contact the ISO - New England Control Room at **Control Room**, who will then establish a link between the VY Control Room and the NRC via their conferencing mode.
- F. Mobile UHF Radio System
 - 1. Description

This system is utilized by all emergency teams and consists of a 100 watt repeater with its high gain antenna mounted on top of the old 150-foot meteorological tower and a 75 watt repeater with its high gain antenna mounted on top of the 330 foot meteorological tower. These repeaters are actuated by six base radio stations located in the following:

- Control Room,
- Gate 1,
- Gate 2,
- Secondary Alarm Station,
- TSC Computer Users Room, and

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
