Regarding the scoping of NRC proposed rule for the release and "recycling" of radioactive waste into everyday commerce (64 FR 35090, 6/30/99), I am strongly opposed to any further release of radioactive materials at any level (beyond existing natural background) into commerce. I believe that such releases will prove to be harmful to the population at large, a result that directly opposes NRC's charge to protect the health and safety of the people. The thought of radioactive materials, however "low level", being sent to landfills or incinerators, or used in construction of homes, schools, workplaces and other buildings, as well as in the production of vehicles and ordinary home products, is simply appalling, especially when proposed by an arm of the federal government that was set up to protect us from such exposure.

Please do not allow any more releases of radioactive waste, halt those activities now going on in that regard, and recapture those materials that have already been released, both nationally and in the international arena.
