I am writing to you because I have recently come to learn that the Nuclear Regulatory Commission has proposed the recycling of radioactive waste into consumer products. Is this true? If so, I ask you please <u>not</u> to recycle radioactive waste into the products that we, consumers, purchase.

I would like to stress the fact that using radioactive waste in consumer products is unnecessary in a country like the U.S., which is so rich in natural resources. The bottom line is that I am concerned about being involuntarily exposed to the radioactivity that is emitted from this radioactive waste.
