I have just learned that there is a program to release low level nuclear waste as raw materials for the manufacture of household goods. I can't believe that you think the public will not erupt in great anger at this, and that we will not see it as a betrayal of the very shaky trust we now invest in gov. I am asking the Nuclear Regulatory Commission to isolate radioactive waste and materials, and anything they contaminate, no matter what level. I understand the difficulty of disposal, but the public is not your garbage can!
