[The issue date for TAC MA4601 is not the date of July 8, 1999, when an amendment was issued to the Wolf Creek Technical specifications. As stated in the amendment letter, there remained an open issue of the proposed ultimate heat sink temperature of 95 degrees. The TAC was closed on September 22, 1999, with the letter that addressed and closed out this issue. The licensee's implementation date for the TAC is not affected because that September 22th letter did not require the licensee to do anything further than was done for the amendment that was issued.
