
Dear Ms. Taylor:

In response to your letter dated November 8, 1999, concerning the expiration of our Reciprocal Recognition of our license for conducting activities using radiation sources in the state of Texas, be advised that The Lane Construction Corporation plans to transfer possession and control of our Troxler Nuclear Density Gauge, Model No. 3440, S/N 22059, to Sunmount Corporation. We are attaching a copy of Sunmount's Radioactive Material License. The Troxler gauge is no longer needed on our project and the transfer will be completed by December 31, 1999.

If The Lane Construction Corporation resumes activities utilizing such gauges, we will reapply for either reciprocity or a full license, depending on the extent of such activities.
