
Subject: SP-98-025 AGREEMENT STATE VIEWS ON COST/IMPACTS

Dear Mr. Bangart:

A copy of our response to SP-97-080-Formerly Licensed Sites And Jurisdiction For Remaining Residual Materials is attached. This letter responds to your questions regarding our formerly licensed sites requested in SP-98-025. The Department has closed the remaining site which adds 35 hours to the estimate the Department originally provided. This site did require decontamination.

The Department applauds your attempt to seek funding to assist in the close-out of NRC's responsibilities in other states. Once funding has been approved, the State of Illinois expects to receive its share for performing responsibilities originally assigned to the NRC.
