
Dear Mr. Peterson:

**REVIEW COMMENTS FOR REVISION 33 OF THE FERMI 2 SECURITY PLAN**

<u>Chapter</u>	<u>Section</u>	<u>Comment</u>
4	4.8.1	<p>The reduction in the frequency of protected area patrols appears excessive. 10 CFR 73.55(c)(4) states that the security plan shall describe that all exterior areas within the protected area are periodically checked to detect the presence of unauthorized persons or material. Regulatory guidance in NUREG - 0908 is random patrols at least every four hours, i.e. twice per eight hour shift or three times in a twelve hour shift. This frequency needs to be included in section 4.8.1 to prevent a reduction in the effectiveness of the security plan.</p>
