MEDICAL STATUS CHANGE AND LICENSE EXPIRATION UPDATE

Gentlemen:

By letter dated October 27, 1999 (Serial: BSEP 99-0173), Carolina Power & Light (CP&L) Company notified the NRC that the individual holding Operator License No. SOP-21142-1 (NRC Docket No. 55-20647) for the Brunswick Steam Electric Plant, Unit Nos. 2 and 1 has experienced a change in medical status. On January 11, 2000, CP&L was notified that this individual has experienced another change in medical status. As described in the enclosed NRC Form 396, CP&L is requesting that a current license restriction be removed. A physician's statement dated January 13, 2000, is also enclosed. This statement provides additional supporting information.

The October 27, 1999, letter also stated that effective April 2, 2000, Operator License No. SOP-21142-1 would expire, and CP&L would provide followup notification in accordance with 10 CFR 50.74 at that time. CP&L no longer intends to terminate this operator license on April 2, 2000.

CP&L requests that the information in the enclosures be withheld from public disclosure in accordance with 10 CFR 2.790(a)(6), since disclosure of this information would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy.
