On December 31, 1999, at 1133 hours, a plant security officer (armed responder) left the site due to a death in the family. As a result, the security force fell below minimum manning requirements for armed responders. An additional security force member was called in and arrived on site at 1155 hours, which is within the prescribed time allotment of the Plant Security Plan (PSP). However, the Duane Arnold Energy Center (DAEC) recently received an NRC position on Regulatory Guide (RG) 5.62, Revision 1, which interprets the guidance as requiring the minimum staffing levels to be reestablished within 10 minutes. This event resulted in a 22-minute period of time with staffing level below the minimum required. There was no effect on the physical security or on any plant safety system as a result of this event. There were no security systems out of service at the time of the event. There were no Local, State, or Federal law enforcement agencies contacted. A one-hour report was made to the NRC at 1213 hours. There is no known media interest and no press release was issued. There are no additional corrective actions. The DAEC security force consists of both proprietary and contract personnel. This report contains no Safeguards information. This report is being submitted in accordance with Appendix G to 10CFR73, paragraph I(c) as supplemented by the referenced NRC staff position to RG 5.62 associated with Unresolved Item 50-331/98018-01.
