
On December 15, 1999, the transfer of the Clinton Power Station (CPS) Operating License from Illinois Power to AmerGen Energy Company, LLC ("AmerGen") became effective. This transfer was approved via NRC Order dated November 24, 1999, and was completed by a conforming license amendment (Amendment 123 to the CPS Operating License) issued on December 15, 1999.

At the time of the transfer of the Operating License, there were five applications for amendment of the CPS Operating License pending NRC review and approval. These amendment requests, which are identified in the attachment to this letter, were submitted by Illinois Power and published for notice in the Federal Register as Illinois Power submittals. Since AmerGen is now the Operating License holder for CPS, AmerGen wishes to express to the NRC its interest in, and adoption of, these requests. Hence, this letter is provided specifically to identify the outstanding amendment requests and to note AmerGen's expectation that the NRC will continue with its efforts to review and process these requests for AmerGen, the licensee for CPS. As the applicability of these requests to CPS remains unchanged, the intent, bases, justification, and evaluations provided or associated with the requested changes (including the Bases for No Significant Hazards Consideration) also remain unchanged.
