Fitness for Duty Program Six Month Performance Report

FITNESS FOR DUTY PROGRAM SUMMARY:

The Waterford 3 annual random testing rate is 50 percent. During this reporting period, approximately 25.5 percent of the population have been randomly tested. The two positive test results occurred in the short-term contractor personnel group during preaccess testing. The rate of positive tests from random testing is 0.00 percent. The total random testing percentage for the year is 51.9 percent.

POSITIVE RESULTS:

As illustrated in the breakdown of confirmed positive tests, there were two positive test results for this reporting period. Of the substances tested for, marijuana was the drug of preference, accounting for 100 percent of the positive results. The Federal Regulation cut-off for marijuana is 100 ng/ml. Entergy, however, uses a more stringent cut-off criteria of 50 ng/ml for marijuana. The positive test results were confirmed at the NRC established cut-off criteria.

MANAGEMENT ACTIONS:

Access was denied to the two short-term contractor personnel that tested positive during pre-access testing. Management was notified and the individuals' files were annotated to reflect the positive results and management's actions.

EVENTS REPORTED TO THE NUCLEAR REGULATORY COMMISSION (NRC):

During this reporting period, there were no reportable violations of the fitness for duty program.

PROGRAM EVALUATION/AUDIT:

No programmatic problems were identified during this reporting period. An internal QA audit was conducted between July 27-August 23, 1999. The results of the QA audit showed the program was being effectively implemented. However, during the audit Condition Report CR-1999-0846 was generated to document a procedural non-compliance concerning the storage requirements of Fitness For Duty records that were being prepared for shipment to another location to be imaged. During the preparation for shipment, these records were not being stored in one-hour fire rated cabinets, as stated in the site-established procedures. The records were promptly returned to fire rated storage cabinets.
