The Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) has requested the Office of the Federal Register to publish the enclosed "Notice of Intent to Cooperate in the Preparation of an Environmental Impact Statement." This notice relates to the Private Fuel Storage (PFS) application, dated June 20, 1997, as amended August 28, 1998, for a license to receive, possess, store, and transfer spent nuclear fuel at an Independent Spent Fuel Storage Installation (ISFSI) to be constructed and operated on the Reservation of the Skull Valley Band of Goshute Indians. On January 5, 2000, PFS filed an application with the Surface Transportation Board (STB) to construct and operate a 32-mile rail line from Skunk Ridge, Utah, to the proposed ISFSI site. STB would normally prepare a separate environmental impact statement (EIS) for rail line construction proposals, but instead has agreed to cooperate in the preparation of an EIS with NRC, the Bureau of Indian Affairs, and the Bureau of Land Management.
