2) Physical Description

This shipment will consist of (8) Cylinders of Uranium Hexafluoride (UF6) in sealed Overpacks. The cylinders are 30-B Cylinders containing 11,700 kgs Uranium enriched to approximately 5% weight of U-235.

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3) Transportation and Route Schedule
