2) Physical Description

This shipment will consist of 240 Drums of Uranium Ore Concentrate (U-308) in 5 x 20' ocean containers. The total weight of the shipment is 95,571.4 kgs. of U-308.

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3) Transportation and Route Schedule

The vessel will sail from Hamburg, Germany on August 15, 1999. The ocean transportation from Hamburg, Germany to Montreal, Quebec, Canada will be the responsibility of Canada Maritime Steamship Line. The vessel will unload at Montreal, Quebec, Canada on or about August 23, 1999. The containers will then be loaded onto the rail for importation to Detroit, MI. The containers will enter the USA at Detroit, MI on or about August 28, 1999, and will continue on rail to St. Louis, MO. The inland transportation from St. Louis, MO to Metropolis, IL will be the responsibility of RSB Logistic Services Inc.
