Withdrawal of Request to Revise Technical Specifications

Ladies and Gentlemen:

On February 5, 1999, Southern Nuclear Operating Company (SNC) submitted a request to revise the Plant Hatch Unit 1 and Unit 2 Technical Specifications by implementing several previously approved industry generic changes. On January 3, 2000, supplemental changes to the initial request were provided.

Subsequent to the subject submittals, it was noted that some of the submitted Bases did not exactly match the industry generic Bases. Therefore, SNC formally withdraws both previous revision requests. An entire revision request package (i.e., the Unit 1 and Unit 2 proposed Technical Specifications and Bases changes) that is consistent with the approved generic changes will be resubmitted in a timely manner.
