STATE OF UTAH'S CORRECTED NOTICE OF DEPOSITION OF NRC STAFF WITNESS REGARDING NRC STAFF SAFETY EVALUATION OF HI-STAR 100 CASK SYSTEM

On February 7, the State of Utah gave notice that at a date and time to be established by mutual consent of the parties¹, the State would take the deposition of an NRC Staff member who is knowledgeable about the technical content of and basis for the Staff's review of the thermal analysis performed by Holtec, International, for the HI-STAR 100 transportation cask system. The State hereby corrects that deposition notice to notify the Staff that it intends to depose a witness with respect to the Staff's review of the thermal analysis for the HI-STAR 100 *storage* cask system, rather than the transportation cask system.

The deposition will take place in the offices of Harmon, Curran, Spielberg, and Eisenberg. The deposition testimony will be taken before a duly authorized court reporter
