Dear Mr. Mocniak:

This refers to your letter dated January 20, 2000, which outlines your plans for a staged startup of Phase II operations of your rare earth recovery facility. These plans were discussed in a telephonic conference call held on January 20, 2000, between Dr. Dennis LaPoint of your staff and Dr. D. Blair Spitzberg of my staff. We have reviewed Fansteel's Phase II startup plan and have no further questions at this time. As discussed in our telephonic conference, we will review the implementation of your commitments and plans for the Phase II startup during our readiness inspection that is scheduled for March 13-17, 2000.

We have also reviewed your letter dated January 25, 2000, in response to our letter and Notice of Violation dated December 23, 1999. Your reply is responsive to the concerns raised in our Notice of Violation. We will review the implementation of your corrective actions during the March 2000 inspection to determine that full compliance has been achieved and will be maintained.
