On January 31, 2000, the NRC completed an inspection conducted at your Palisades Nuclear Generating Plant. The enclosed report presents the results of that inspection.

The inspection covered a 6-week period. Areas examined during the inspection are identified in the report. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of a selective examination of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observations of activities in progress. The purpose of the inspection effort was to determine whether activities authorized by the license were conducted safely and in accordance with NRC requirements.

During this inspection period, we observed that your Year 2000 Project Team effectively precluded any potential problems associated with the transition to Year 2000. Also, you demonstrated a positive focus on safety through implementation of contingency actions to mitigate any potential problems during the transition to Year 2000. In addition, your staff appropriately addressed secondary system water chemistry issues regarding elevated sodium concentrations. No violations or deviations of NRC requirements were identified.
