The NRC has received requests for the subject letter. Although the majority of information in the subject cure letter involves contractual information related to the Government's contracts with SAIC, the agency must determine what portions of the document, if any, should be withheld from public disclosure due to the presence of any confidential business (proprietary) information.

Your justification should answer the following questions in sufficient detail in order to permit the NRC to arrive at a determination as to what portions of the document, if any, should be withheld from disclosure.

1. Was the information transmitted to and received by the NRC in confidence? Please provide details.
2. To the best of your knowledge, is the information currently available in public sources?
3. Does your company customarily treat this information, or this type of information as confidential? Please explain why.
4. Would public disclosure of this information be likely to cause substantial harm to the competitive position of your company? If so, how?
5. Since this information was transmitted to the NRC, have any events altered the proprietary character of the information? If so, please explain.

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Please provide your response to me by 3:00 p.m. on January 4, 2000.
