SUPPLEMENT TO AMENDMENT TO REQUEST FOR HEARING BY CANTON TOWNSHIP, PENNSYLVANIA,

FIRST AMENDMENT TO REQUEST FOR HEARING BY CANTON TOWNSHIP, PENNSYLVANIA ON LICENSEE'S AMENDMENT REQUEST FOR DECOMMISSIONING OF ITS CANTON TOWNSHIP FACILITY,

AND

SUPPLEMENTAL REPLY OF PETITIONER CANTON TOWNSHIP TO NRC STAFF'S RESPONSE (collectively referred to as "Supplemental Responses")

Petitioner/Requestor CANTON TOWNSHIP, by its counsel, hereby files the following Supplemental Responses to correct the record concerning actual allegations which have come to Petitioner/Requestor's attention subsequent to its last filing, as follows:

1. On or about June 28, 1999, Canton Township filed a Request for Hearing in Docket Nos. 040-08794 and 040-08778 on Molycorp's License Amendment Request regarding its schedule for submission of a revised Site Decommissioning Plan and Environmental Report.

2. On or about November 11, 1999, as directed by the NRC Presiding Officer, Canton Township filed an Amendment to its Initial Request for Hearing.

3. On or about December 13, 1999, Canton Township filed a Request for Hearing on Molycorp's Amendment Request for decommissioning of its Canton Township facility.

4. On or about February 9, 2000, Canton Township filed a Reply to the NRC Staff's Response.

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5. As set forth in the record in this matter, Licensee/Molycorp, Inc. has proposed a temporary storage of ten years for certain radioactive by-products and/or waste, which material is currently located in Molycorp's York, Pennsylvania facility and will be located within the municipal boundaries of Canton Township.

6. Molycorp, Inc. has stockpiled certain radioactive by-products and/or waste, presently located within the municipal boundaries of Canton Township.

7. Thereafter, on or about May 8, 1984, Molycorp, Inc. entered into a Contractual Consent of Landowner with Canton Township to which is attached a map showing the existence of a Right-of-Way owned by the Tylerdale Connecting Railroad (hereinafter referred to as "Right-of-Way"). A true and correct copy of the Contractual Consent of Landowner found at Deed Book Volume 2153, Pages 97-101, including a site map recorded in the Recorder of Deeds Office of Washington County, Pennsylvania, is attached hereto, incorporated herein and marked as Exhibit "A."

8. Molycorp, Inc. has proposed to store the aforesaid radioactive by-products and/or waste at both permanent and temporary sites on or near the Right of Way.

9. To the best of Canton Township's knowledge, information and belief, the aforesaid Right-of-Way is still owned by the Tylerdale Connecting Railroad Company. The records of the Tax Assessors' Office for Washington County, Pennsylvania lists this Right-of-Way as exempt property titled to the Tylerdale Connecting Railroad Company. A true and correct copy of the Tax Assessors' records dated February 10, 2000 identifying the Right-of-Way as exempt property titled to the Tylerdale Connecting Railroad Company is attached hereto, incorporated herein and marked as Exhibit "B."

10. The Right-of-Way owned by the Tylerdale Connecting Railroad is subject to and governed by 66 Pa.C.S.A. §709 entitled "Disposition of Real Property by Public Utility Engaged in Railroad Business," which states in part that the Right-of-Way must first be offered to the local municipality for public use. Any disposition which fails to comply with the statute is <u>voidable</u>.

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11. Canton Township has in the past developed preliminary plans to create public recreational facilities in the area near Molycorp Inc.'s property. The subject Right-of-Way would be an important part of those public recreational facilities.

12. Molycorp, Inc. has proposed both a temporary and permanent storage facility of certain radioactive by-products and/or waste on or near real estate it does not own.

13. Storage of the aforesaid radioactive by-products and/or waste at both permanent and temporary sites would adversely affect the health, safety and welfare of potential users of Canton Township's proposed public recreational facility.

14. For the reasons set forth herein, together with those previously presented in its filings, Canton Township reiterates that it has established its need for and a right to a hearing under 10 CFR, §2.1205(h) relating to Molycorp's Site Decommissioning Plan and that in view of the interrelatedness of the issues and concerns set forth in the Site Decommissioning Plan and the proceeding concerning the temporary storage of the York material, the two proceedings should be consolidated.

WHEREFORE, Petitioner/Requestor Canton Township, Pennsylvania hereby respectfully requests a hearing before the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission on these proceedings.

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

CONTRACTUAL CONSENT OF LANDOWNER

(i)(We), the undersigned, hereinafter sometimes referred to as "landowner", being the owner(s) of acres of land located in _____ Canton_Township 16.5 MOROLITH OR OTO _ County, Pennsylvania, as described in the deed(s) recorded in the Recorder Washington __ and shown by crosshatched of Deeds Office at Deed Book(s) and page(s) (See attached page) lines on the map attached hereto which is signed in the original by the landowner upon which _proposes to engage in hazardous waste Molycorp, Inc. ANTE MANAGEMENT FACELITY OPERATOR storage, treatment or disposal activities for which application for permit will be made to the Department of Environmental Resources under the Pennsylvania Solid Waste Management Act, Act of July 7, 1980 (P.L.380,35 P.S.16018.10 et seq., and of which application this consent will be made a part, DO HEREBY ACKNOWLEDGE THAT THE HAZARDOUS WASTE MANAGEMENT FACILITY OPERATOR AND HIS PERSONNEL HAVE THE RIGHT TO ENTER UPON AND USE THE LAND FOR THE PURPOSES OF CONDUCTING HAZARDOUS WASTE MANAGEMENT ACTIVITIES. Furthermore, (I)(We), the undersigned, do hereby irrevocably grant to the hazardous waste management facility operator and to the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania or any of its authorized agents, or employees, the right to enter upon the sforesaid land before the beginning of the hazardous waste management activities, during the hazardous waste management activities and for a period of 20 years after final closure of the facility, for the purposes of inspection and for the purpose of conducting such pollution abatement or pollution prevention activities required under the Act, the regulations promulgated thereunder and the terms of the permit as the Department deems necessary. (I)(We) do hereby grant in addition to the Commonwealth, for the aforesaid period of time, a right of entry across any adjoining or contiguous lands owned by (us)(me) in order to have access to the land described herein. It is specifically agreed and understood that this contractual consent gives the Commonwealth the right to enter, inspect the premises, and abate or prevent pollution as a matter within the police power but does not obligate the Commonwealth to do so, does not constitute any ownership interest by the Commonwealth in the aforesaid land, and does not affect or limit any rights available to the Commonwealth under applicable law.



THE LANDOWNER TO ALLOW THE ABOVE-NAMED HAZARDOUS WASTE MANAGEMENT FACILITY OPERATOR TO TRANSFER OR ASSIGN, BY WRITTEN AGREEMENT, THIS CONTRACTUAL CONSENT TO ANOTHER HAZARDOUS WASTE MANAGEMENT FACILITY OPERATOR.

This Contractual Consent shall be deemed to be a recordable document. Prior to the initiation of hazardous waste management facility operations under the permit, this Consent shall be recorded by <u>Molycorp, Inc.</u> and entered into the deed book (d.b.v.) index at the office of the recorder of deeds in the county(ies) in which the hazardous waste management facility is to be located.


