## **SUMMARY OF MANAGEMENT ACTIONS**

### **General Information**

During the second 6-month period of 1999, the average population granted unescorted access was 1630 individuals. A total of 392 random drug tests were performed, which yielded a random testing rate of 24.0% at the close of the 6-month testing period. However for the 12-month period, the average population granted unescorted access was 1707 individuals. The year-end total of 875 random drug tests yielded an annual random testing rate of 51.26%.

During the 6-month reporting period there were 1295 individuals tested, of which five were confirmed positive for illegal substances. The testing failure rate (% positive) was 0.62%, this included three refusals to test.

Three contractors refused drug testing during pre-access in-processing. In each case after the breathalyzer test, all three contractors did not provide an acceptable urine sample for testing and opted to sign a drug test refusal form. These individuals were not granted unescorted access to ANO.

Five other contractors tested positive during pre-badge inprocessing and were not granted unescorted access to ANO.

There were no for-cause drug tests conducted during this 6-month reporting period.

### **Program Initiatives**

The random testing program became Y2K compliant when it was converted from MS Access 2.0 to MS Access 97.

The FFD department merged with the Access Authorization department. An overall Entergy Operations Inc. reorganization effort prompted this change.

### **Appeals**

There were no appeals or requests for a retest during the 6-month reporting period.

### **NRC Reportable Events**

There were no FFD events that met the NRC 24 hour telephonic reporting requirement.
