With this letter United Nuclear submits its quarterly analysis of reclamation costs as required in license condition No. 25 of our License SUA-1475 for the Church Rock site. This analysis is for the fourth quarter of 1999.

FOURTH QUARTER 1999 COSTS

The costs incurred for tailings reclamation in the fourth quarter of 1999 totaled \$87,384.00. Consistent with the Annual Surety Estimate all costs incurred in the fourth quarter 1999 were in the area of seepage cleanup actions. These costs reflects the continued operation of the seepage cleanup program.

The costs incurred in the fourth quarter of 1999 for seepage cleanup activities were as follows;
