Dear Mr. Reandeau:

By Order dated November 24, 1999, the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) approved the transfer of the license for the Clinton Power Station (CPS) held by Illinois Power Company (IP) to AmerGen Energy Company, LLC, and approval of a conforming amendment pursuant to Sections 50.80 and 50.90 of Title 10 of the Code of Federal Regulations. The license transfer was completed on December 15, 1999, and the conforming amendment to License No. NPF-62 was issued on that date.

By letter dated December 21, 1999, I forwarded to you a request to sign Amendment No. 5 to Indemnity Agreement No. B-91 to reflect the license transfer. Subsequently, a member of your staff informed me that the Amendment should be No. 6 to Indemnity Agreement B-91. Consequently, you should disregard the request of December 21, 1999, and we are issuing the correct Indemnity Agreement Amendment (No. 6) by this letter.

Enclosed are three originals signed by the NRC amending Indemnity Agreement No. B-91 to reflect the license transfer. I request that you have Illinois Power Company and AmerGen

AMENDMENT NO. 6

Effective December 15, 1999, Indemnity Agreement No. B-91, between Illinois Power Company and the Nuclear Regulatory Commission, dated August 7, 1985, as amended, is hereby further amended as follows:

Delete the name "Illinois Power Company" wherever it appears in the indemnity agreement and substitute the name "AmerGen Energy Company, LLC."
