I just called with my request to you, but thought I'd better write also. My understanding is that you would send me a free copy of the proposed COC for Holtec International HI-STAR 100 ~~100~~ <sup>100</sup> cash system for public comment.

I was also interested in the "Future Rulemaking Procedures" paragraph (Fed Reg p 1543) on the use of direct final rules for future additions and revisions to the list of approved spent fuel storage casks. I find it strange this is tacked on the end of a Fed. Reg. notice for one cask system. Certainly this should be put in the form of a proposed rule shouldn't it? Will it be? If so please send a copy. If you are thinking of changing how you proceed with rulemaking procedures for accepting COC's for cask designs in the future, I request it be done in a formal rulemaking in the Fed Reg. and up for public comment. The paragraph added on to the Holtec proposed rule about this possible "future rulemaking procedure" says you are requesting comments on this, but no address is given to send the comments to in this proposal.
