“DIFFERING PROFESSIONAL OPINION ON STEAM GENERATOR  
TUBE INTEGRITY ISSUES”

This memorandum is in response to your continuing concern over the appointment of Wayne Hodges to the *ad hoc* panel which is being formed to address your “Differing Professional Opinion [DPO] on Steam Generator Tube Integrity Issues.” As I indicated in my February 23, 2000, memorandum, I have carefully reviewed Mr. Hodges’ management role with regard to the Office of Nuclear Regulatory Research’s support of the Office of Nuclear Reactor Regulation’s development of NUREG-1570 before issuing that memorandum. I also spoke with Mr. Hodges about his role and the importance of assuring an objective review of the issues in your DPO. The information in your March 1, 2000, memorandum did not provide any new insights that would alter my view of the character and substance of Mr. Hodges’ contribution to that effort. I continue to be confident that Mr. Hodges can and will serve as an objective and productive member of this panel.
