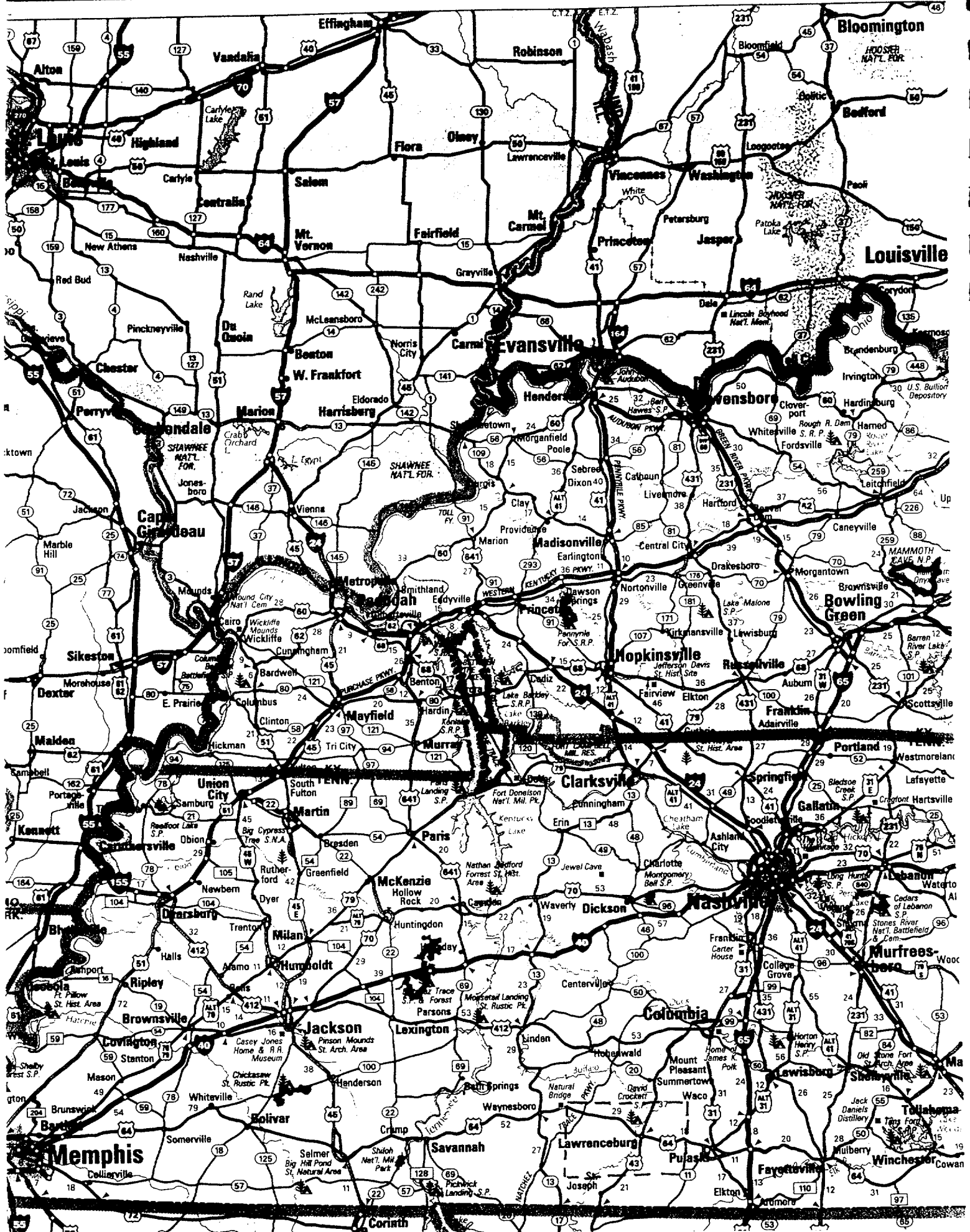


Figure 1 UCAR Site Map
