This will serve as my request for disclosure of all information, along with production of copies of any and all documents maintained by your agency, including any and all divisions, branches, units, offices, bureaus, or subsidiary components thereof, and, likewise, including any precursor agencies, related to the following subject:

The operation of a "radioactive waste disposal" program on or by ships and or other units or personnel of the Military Sea Transportation Service (now designated the Military Sealift Command), during the period from 1951 to 1964, inclusive.

I am specifically interested in the general nature of the program, including its extent and dates of operation, and in the participation in the program of the ship USNS GOLDEN EAGLE (T-AF 52), on which my grandfather served.

This request is made pursuant to the federal Freedom of Information Act, codified as Title V, United States Code, Section 552, and extends to any and all documents, without regard to the form or format in which such documents may be maintained, and without regard to the name or other designator assigned to any such documents or files.

Should you determine that another federal agency is presently in possession of the requested information or documents, kindly inform me of such fact, and forward my request to that agency or agencies.

Should you determine that any part of the information requested hereby is classified, sensitive, or otherwise exempt from disclosure, kindly provide the remaining portions of the record, along with an index of the portions for which exemption is claimed, together with a citation of which rule, regulation, directive, or statute is relied upon in claiming exemption.

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
