

SYNOPSIS

The Office of Investigations, U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), Region II, initiated this investigation on August 26, 1997, to determine whether NDT Services, Inc., retaliated against several radiographers/assistant radiographers for raising concerns regarding safety and training issues. The investigation also addressed numerous other issues including: health physics practices, employee training and qualification, unsupervised radiography, records falsification, and failure to report a source disconnect incident.

The investigation did not substantiate the discrimination issues, but documented numerous violations of NRC regulations including the deliberate failure to report a source disconnect incident.
