GENERIC LETTER 83-11 SUPPLEMENT 1

In accordance with Generic Letter (GL) 83-11, Supplement 1, dated June 24, 1999, Virginia Electric and Power Company is developing and will implement a program that meets the guidelines delineated in Attachment 1 of GL 83-11, Supplement 1. The program will qualify and allow the use of NRC-approved analysis methods for performing safety-related evaluations. Consistent with the NRC's request for notification, the date of our first licensing application using the GL 83-11, Supplement 1 guidelines will be after July 1, 2000.

Consistent with the guidance provided in GL 83-11, Supplement 1, the only codes and methods included in this program are those that the NRC has reviewed and approved generically or has otherwise accepted/approved for inclusion into the licensing basis for another plant. This program and its implementation will be conducted under the control of the Operational Quality Assurance Program.
