MEMORANDUM AND ORDER (Request for Scheduling Information)

Contention Utah S, Decommissioning, has been denominated as one of the matters to be heard during the scheduled June 2000 evidentiary hearing on Groups I-II/A contentions. In a separate ruling this date the Licensing Board denies a motion by intervenor State of Utah (State) to admit late-filed issues regarding contention Utah S, see LBP-00-08, 51 NRC __ (Mar. 21, 2000), thereby establishing the litigable scope of this contention. Consequently, the Board requests that on or before Thursday, March 23, 2000, the parties provide it with a joint filing that outlines (1) a best estimate of how many hearing days will be required to litigate contention Utah S; and (2) whether, and to what

extent, the litigation of this contention will involve proprietary information.
