The use of radioactively contaminated scrap metal for re-use in making steel and other products. While the low grade radioactivity may be an acceptable rate in any one product, when several products are combined, as in making a car, the total may reach dangerously high levels, especially for children, when they spend a lot of time exposed to it — as when touring on vacation, for their parents who must drive for a living (Truckers, Cabbies, Salesmen etc.) So much contamination cannot be avoided That where it is possible to reduce exposure, it seems That we should do so. To promote use of radioactive materials is inexcusable.
