Dear Mr. Hutchinson:

By letter dated December 12, 1997, you applied for an amendment to Operating License No. DPR-51. The proposed change would have established an alternate repair criteria for the segment of steam generator tubes that are located within the upper tube sheet. Your staff had verbally requested that the review of your amendment request be stopped pending a significantly revised submittal. Subsequently, by letter dated December 15, 1998, you withdrew the amendment request, noting that a future submittal, with the significantly revised basis, was planned.

The Commission has filed the enclosed Notice of Withdrawal of Application for Amendment to Facility Operating License with the Office of the Federal Register for publication.

The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (the Commission) has granted the request of Entergy Operations, Inc. (the licensee) to withdraw its December 12, 1997, application for proposed amendment to Facility Operating License No. DPR-51 for Arkansas Nuclear One, Unit No. 1, located in Pope County, Arkansas.


The proposed amendment would have established an alternate repair criteria for the segment of steam generator tubes that are located within the upper tube sheet.

The Commission had previously issued a Notice of Consideration of Issuance of Amendment published in the FEDERAL REGISTER on February 11, 1998 (63 FR 6984). However, by letter dated December 15, 1998, the licensee withdrew the proposed change.
