Gentlemen:

This letter will supplement the Application for Transfer and Amendment of License Number TR-2, Docket Number 50-022 ("Application") filed by CBS Corporation ("CBS") by letter from Louis J. Briskman, Executive Vice President and General Counsel of CBS to Mr. Samuel J. Collins of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission ("NRC") dated February 14, 2000. That Application previously was supplemented by my letter, as counsel to CBS Corporation, to the NRC dated March 8, 2000.

Attachment 1 to my March 8, 2000 letter was a list of directors and principal officers of Viacom Inc. ("Viacom") as of the effective date of the merger, together with their addresses and citizenship. With the exception of one member of the Board of Directors who is a citizen of Denmark, all of the Directors and all of the principal officers of Viacom as of the effective date of the merger will be citizens of the United States. Viacom is not and will not, as of the effective date, be owned, controlled or dominated by an alien, a foreign corporation or a foreign government.

Viacom is incorporated in the State of Delaware.

Revision 3 to the the Technical and Environmental Specifications applicable to activities at the Test Reactor (TR), Waltz Mill Site, under provisions of NRC License Number TR-2 (Docket 50-022) (which Technical and Environmental Specifications are Appendix A to the Test Reactor Decommissioning Plan) was submitted to the NRC staff for review earlier this month. CBS requests that the Technical Specifications, as revised, be incorporated in the license amendment requested by the Application. Revision 3 to the Technical Specifications would change the name of the "Westinghouse Test Reactor" by deleting the name "Westinghouse". The revision also would substitute Viacom Inc. for CBS Corporation where the CBS name appears in the Technical Specifications.
