What allowable radiation levels are possible for cars, cookware, medical devices, and children's toys? I would think that 0 (ZERO) radiation levels would be the only level you could tolerate in equipment to be used daily by the public.

Any recycling of nuclear waste into the public use sector should be prohibited.

All recycling of nuclear waste must be within the nuclear industry itself. The nuclear industry already has monitoring devices to measure radiation and can regulate radiation exposure.
