DESCRIPTION OF MATERIALS OR FACILITIES

The licensee is authorized to export 10,000.0 curies tritium in the form of plated sources, tritium tritide and scandium tritide. The license is amended to 1) change the name of the licensee from Western Atlas International, Inc., Baker Atlas to Baker Hughes Oilfield Operations, Inc; 2) extend the expiration date from 31 May 2000 to 31 May 2010; and 3) change licensee's address (address change to become effective on or about May 1, 2000).

The following conditions apply:

1) No tritium in bulk gaseous form is authorized for export under this license; 2) No more than 1,000 curies can be exported to any country listed as restricted destinations in 10 CFR 110.29.

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Neither this license nor any right under this license shall be assigned or otherwise transferred in violation of the provisions of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended and the Energy Reorganization Act of 1974.

This license is subject to the right of recapture or control by Section 108 of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended and to all of the other provisions of said Acts, now or hereafter in effect and to all valid rules and regulations of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission.
