Dear Mr. Campbell:

By letter dated March 28, 2000, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission issued Amendment No. 240 to Facility Operating License No. NPF-3 for the Davis-Besse Nuclear Power Plant. The amendment revised the Technical Specifications in response to your application dated July 26, 1999 (Serial Number 2572, License Amendment Request No. 96-0012), as supplemented by submittal dated December 7, 1999 (Serial Number 2629).

Subsequent to receiving this license amendment, your staff informed us that Technical Specification Index page XV from Amendment No. 240 was misnumbered and did not reflect changes made in recent license amendments. In addition, your staff informed us that page XV from Amendment No. 236 did not reflect changes made in Amendment No. 235. The enclosed page XV, which is being reissued, does not need to be reissued for Amendment No. 236 because it has been superseded by Amendment No. 240.
