As you know, the U.S. Agency for International Development (AID), the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), and the Departments of State and Energy have been working closely together since 1991 to address urgent safety concerns at operating Soviet-designed nuclear power plants in the countries of the former Soviet Union (FSU) and in Central and Eastern Europe (CEE). To date, NRC has received in excess \$40 million from AID to support regulatory strengthening efforts with the FSU and CEE countries. Organizationally, NRC regulatory strengthening efforts for our Russian and Ukrainian counterparts have been managed primarily by the Office of the Executive Director for Operations, while NRC regulatory strengthening efforts for our Armenian, Bulgarian, Czech, Hungarian, Kazakhstani, Lithuanian and Slovak counterparts have been managed primarily by the Office of International Programs.

The purpose of this letter is to advise you that effective immediately NRC will consolidate responsibility for all of our AID-funded nuclear safety-related assistance activities with the FSU and CEE countries into the Office of International Programs (OIP).
