On, April 26-27, 2006, the US Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) conducted a security inspection at your University of Utah TRIGA Research Reactor facility. The inspection included a review of activities authorized for your facility. The enclosed report presents the results of that inspection.

The inspection examined activities conducted under your license as they relate to security and compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations, implementation of certain compensatory measures, and compliance with the conditions of your license. The inspector reviewed selected procedures and records, observed activities, and interviewed personnel. Based on the results of this inspection, no safety concerns or noncompliance with NRC requirements were identified. No response to this letter is required.
